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Teen Ranch Year 4 Overnight Camp

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

Students in Year 4 are invited to attend a two-day camp from Monday 30th October 2023 to Tuesday 31st October 2023 at Teen Ranch 352 Cobbitty Road, Cobbitty situated on the Nepean River overlooking Camden Valley. Details are as follows:

Arrive at school by 7:45am on Monday 30th October as we will be departing school at 8:15am promptly. We will depart Teen Ranch on Tuesday, 31st October at 3:00pm to arrive back at school by 4:00pm.

Activities that the children *may* participate in at the camp include archery, crate climb, giant swing, challenge course, bush skills, orienteering, canoeing, & rock climbing. The children will stay in airconditioned bunkhouse style accommodation. Details regarding items the children will need to bring will be provided closer to the departure date. The cost of the camp is **\$360.00** which includes camp fees and meals plus travel by seat belted coach to and from the venue. Payment can be made in full or by instalments prior to camp.

A non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 **must** be received with the attached permission note by **Thursday 6th April 2023**.

If you are not paying in instalments the \$50 deposit is still required by Thursday 6th April 2023 to secure a spot. **Full final payment is needed by Thursday 12th October 2023**.

Teachers attending the excursion have Emergency Care, CPR and Anaphylaxis training. An equipment list and medical form will be sent out closer to the date of the camp.
