Some general housekeeping...

- Just a reminder about any change of legal circumstances – we need to see any court orders (originals) or documents pertaining to access to students – and if these orders are rescinded or changed, we also need these details in writing.
- A reminder that the Kiss and Drop Zone at the front of the school is not to be used to wait for your child for a long time.
- Our staff car parks are for Department of Education staff only. The only exceptions are for those people with a current disability permit. This can either be the RMS official permit or our Clairgate permit which is issued under special circumstances. The car park at the back of the school is for some staff overflow and for some Wingaru parents and Department of

Education Transport staff to pick up and drop off students in Wingaru only. Some people who are not entitled to do so, are using the car parks as a drop off or pick up point. This is becoming both dangerous and frustrating for those who need to use our car parks. Please respect our school and do not drive into the carpark unless you are entitled to do so.

- NAMES - please label your child's belongings with their name. This includes, bags, hats, lunch and drink bottles, clothing etc.
- Glass bottles - please do NOT send your child with any glass bottles or containers – we have had several instances of glass breakage in the playground which is very unsafe.
- Birthday Cakes – if your child has a birthday and you would like to give everyone a treat, the class teacher is happy to give out little birthday cakes at the end of the day for the children to take home – however we ask that you only bring in store bought cakes with the ingredients fully listed.
- E-Scooters – Just a reminder that e-scooters are not allowed at school.
