Our Morning Routine

As Covid restrictions have eased, we have changed our Morning Routine. All children now come into the main Canteen Quad area from 8.30am to 8.45am. If children arrive after 8.45am, they walk straight to their classroom. Children still walk into school by themselves, however if parents feel they need to walk

their children into the school they must stop at the BLUE line on the pathways and wave goodbye to their child. If children are late to school (after 9.00am) they will need to go to the front office for a late note. All late arrivals need to be explained.

Afternoon Pick Up this week due to the Weather event

We have closed the gate near the Pedestrian Crossing and we have also closed the Front Grass Area because of flooding. From today, and for the next few days, our 2 Undercover Quad Areas will be available for parents to wait to pick up their children. K-2 parents may wait in the Canteen Quad Area and 3-6 parents may wait in the Hard Court Quad Area.

We ask that parents do not wait near any classrooms. We also ask that parents provide umbrellas and/or wet weather clothing on these inclement days if possible.

Canteen

Unfortunately, the canteen will be closed on Thursday (3rd March), and Friday (4th March) this week. Please ensure your child has sufficient food and drinks for both recess and lunch. Sorry for the inconvenience.

STAFF CAR PARK

Our staff car parks are for Department of Education staff only. The only exceptions are for those people with a current disability permit. This can either be the RMS official permit or our Clairgate permit which is issued under special circumstances. The car park at the back of the school is for some staff overflow and for the Department of Education Transport staff to pick up and drop off students in Wingaru. Some people who are not entitled to do so, are using the car parks as a drop off or pick up point. This is becoming both dangerous and frustrating for those who need to use our car parks. Please DO NOT use this carpark unless you have permission to do so.
